Public Notice | Wind Turbine Deliveries



As part of the construction of Golticlay Wind Farm, near Lybster, we will soon be starting the delivery of wind turbine components, including the large blades.

Golticlay's wind turbine blades require a specialist transport vehicle, known as a blade lifter, to navigate safely through the narrow streets of Wick. The blade lifter angles the blade in order to turn tight corners. For more information on this, please head to our website below.

Delivery period and timings

Deliveries are currently planned to take place from early April to July 2026 although dates may change due to weather and operational requirements.

Movements will take place during daytime hours and confirmed updates will be shared via the project webpage. A delivery tracker will be available via the project webpage during the delivery period to support journey planning.
