**AND UPON** the Second Defendant and Greenpeace Limited (which is joined to these proceedings as Third Defendant for the purpose of giving the undertaking hereinafter referred to) having agreed terms including undertakings provided by those Defendants to the Court on 24 October 2025 annexed to this Order at Schedule 4 ("the Undertakings")

AND UPON the Court having accepted the Undertakings

AND UPON READING the Witness Statements of Rachel Jane Smith dated 1 October 2025, William Henry Jeffery dated 1 October 2025, and Donal Patrick Kelly dated 20 October 2025

AND UPON HEARING Timothy Morshead KC and Jacqueline Lean for the Claimant

**AND UPON** the Claimant giving and the Court accepting the undertakings set out in Schedule 1 to this Order

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

#### **INJUNCTION**

- 1. The First Defendants must not enter, occupy or remain on, or damage or deface any part (including the perimeter fence), of the land and premises shown edged red on Plans 1 to 6 to this Order, being:
  - (i) Staythorpe Power Station, Staythorpe, Newark, NG23 5RQ, as shown edged red on Plan 1;
  - (ii) Didcot Power Station, Didcot, Oxfordshire, OX11 7YU, as shown edged red on Plan 2;
  - (iii) Pembroke Power Station, Pembroke, West Pennar, Dyfed, SA71 5SS, as shown edged red on Plan 3;
  - (iv) Little Barford Power Station, Little Barford, St Neots, Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire, PE19 6YT, as shown edged red on Plan 4;
  - (v) Great Yarmouth Power Station, , South Denes Road, Great Yarmouth, NR303PY, as shown edged red on Plan 5.
  - (vi) Kings Lynn Power Station, Kings Lynn, PE34 3RD, as shown edged red on Plan6.
- 2. In respect of anything prohibited by paragraph 1 above, the First Defendants must not (a) do it himself/herself/themselves in any other way or (b) do it by means of another person acting on his/her/their behalf, or acting on his/her/their instructions.

#### **REVIEW**

3. The injunction set out at paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order shall be reviewed annually on each anniversary of the Order (or as close to this date as is convenient having regard to the Court's list) with a time estimate of 2 ½ hours. The Claimant shall file and serve any evidence in support 14 days before the review hearing. Skeleton Arguments shall be filed at Court, with a bundle of authorities, not less than 2 days

before the hearing. The injunction set out at paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order shall lapse at 4pm on the anniversary of the order (or as the case may be the latest annual review) unless, before then, the Claimant has applied for the review to take place, such application to be made not less than 3 months before the date on which the injunction would otherwise lapse. Provided such application is made not less than 3 months before the anniversary of the order (or as the case may be the latest annual review) the Court shall list the review hearing on or before the date on which the injunction set out at paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order would otherwise lapse.

#### SERVICE AND NOTIFICATION

- 4. Service of this Order on the First Defendant is dispensed with, pursuant to CPR 6.28 and 81.4(2)(c).
- 5. This Order be notified to the First Defendants by the Claimant carrying out each of the following steps:
  - (i) Uploading a copy on to the following website: <a href="https://uk.rwe.com/injunction">https://uk.rwe.com/injunction</a>
  - (ii) Affixing a copy of the Order in A4 size in a clear plastic envelope at prominent locations at each of the Sites shown edged red on Plans 1 to 6.
- (iii) Affixing warning notices of A2 size at those locations at each of the sites shown edged red on Plans 1 to 6, substantially in the form of the notice at Schedule 3.
- 6. Notification to the First Defendants of any further applications or documents shall be effected by the Claimants carrying out each of the following steps:
  - (i) Uploading a copy of the application on to the following website: <a href="https://uk.rwe.com/injunction">https://uk.rwe.com/injunction</a>

- (ii) Affixing notices at or near the aforesaid prominent locations at the relevant Site/s shown edged red on Plans 1-6, stating that the application has been made or document/s provided and where the application or document/s can be accessed in hard copy and online.
- 7. In respect of paragraphs 5 and 6 above, effective notification will be deemed to have taken place in relation to each Site on the date on which all the relevant steps have been carried out.
- 8. For the avoidance of doubt, in respect of the steps referred to at paragraphs 5(ii), 5(iii), and 6(ii), effective notification will be deemed to have taken place when the documents have all been first affixed regardless of whether they are subsequently removed or defaced without the Claimant's consent.
- 9. The Claimant shall use reasonable endeavours to maintain and as the case may be replace the documents in their fixed positions and in legible form.
- 10. In relation to the Second Defendant: pursuant to CPR rule 6.27, the Claimant has permission to serve the Second Defendant with this Order and any further applications or documents in the Claim by email to:

- 11. In relation to the Third Defendant: pursuant to CPR rule 6.27, the Claimant has permission to serve the Third Defendant with this Order and any further applications or documents in the Claim by email to:

  - (ii) jack.robirosa@greenpeace.org
- 12. The deemed date of service of any documents referred to in paragraphs 10 and 11 above shall be the day on which service is completed in accordance with paragraph 10 or 11 above.

13. The Claimant shall use reasonable endeavours to notify the owners (where known) of the areas of land shown hatched blue on Plans 1A, 2A,4A, 5A and 6A at Annexure 2 to the Particulars of Claim of this Order by not later than 5pm on 31 October 2025.

#### **VARIATION**

- 14. Anyone interested may apply to the Court at any time to vary or discharge this Order or so much of it as affects that person but they must first give the Claimant 48 hours' notice of such application. If any evidence is to be relied upon in support of the application the substance of it must be communicated in writing to the Claimant at least 24 hours in advance of any hearing.
- 15. Any person applying to vary or discharge this Order must provide their full name, address and address for service.
- 16. The Claimant has liberty to apply to vary this Order.

#### **OTHER ORDERS**

- 17. The Third Defendant is joined as a party to this claim pursuant to the Claimant's application dated 23 October 2025.
- 18. It shall be sufficient for the Claimant to notify the First Defendant of the application dated 23 October 2025 by undertaking the step specified in paragraph 6(i) of this Order, namely by uploading a copy of the application on to the following website: https://uk.rwe.com/injunction.
