

NOTICE OF DECISION

RWE Renewables UK Onshore Wind Limited

As directed by regulation 23(4) of the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) 2017, notice is hereby given that RWE Renewables UK Onshore Wind Limited (“the Company”) with company registration number 03758407, having its registered office at Windmill Business Park, Whitehill Way, Swindon, England, SN5 6PB has been granted consent by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate a 10 turbine wind farm known as Lorg wind farm, with a ground to blade tip height of up to 200m metres), on land located between Carsphairn (approximately 11km to the southwest), Sanquhar (approximately 12.3km to the northeast) and New Cumnock (approximately 10.5km to the north), in the relevant Planning Authority area of Dumfries & Galloway Council and East Ayrshire.

Scottish Ministers have also directed, under Section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted.
