Reef Cubes® Make a Splash in Marine Conservation

RWE and ARC Marine have achieved a global first by deploying over 75,000 Reef Cubes® at Rampion Offshore Wind Farm, off the coast of Sussex. These eco-engineered, modular structures not only protect turbine foundations from seabed erosion but also create thriving marine habitats.



The low carbon Reef Cubes® are made near Truro from recycled waste aggregate from Cornish clay mines, offering more than double the habitat volume compared to traditional rock-based scour protection. This innovative approach aligns with RWE's commitment to biodiversity-positive offshore wind projects.

North Wales to Get a Renewable Boost: Alwen Forest Wind Farm Approved

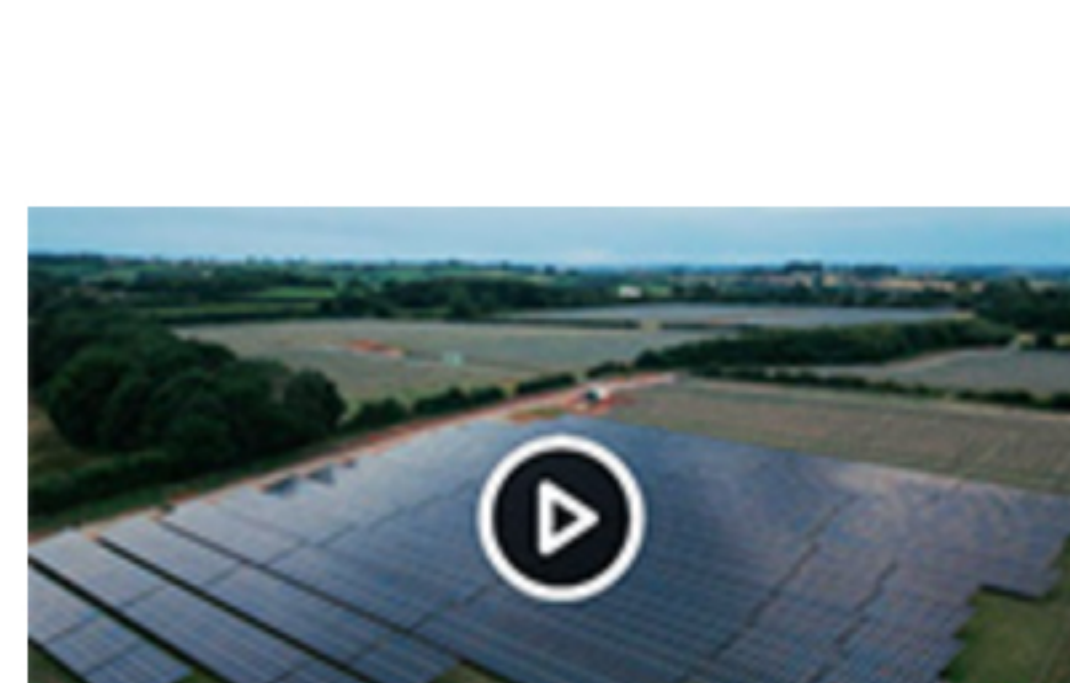
RWE has received the green light for the 60 MW Alwen Forest Wind Farm in North Wales. With nine turbines set to provide enough energy for up to 70,600 homes, this project brings clean, local energy to the heart of the community. During the construction phase, the project is expecting to invest nearly £10m in the Conwy and Denbighshire County Council areas via the project's supply chain, creating around 270 jobs.

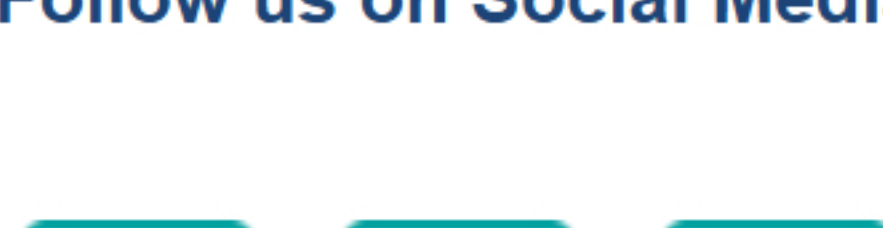
