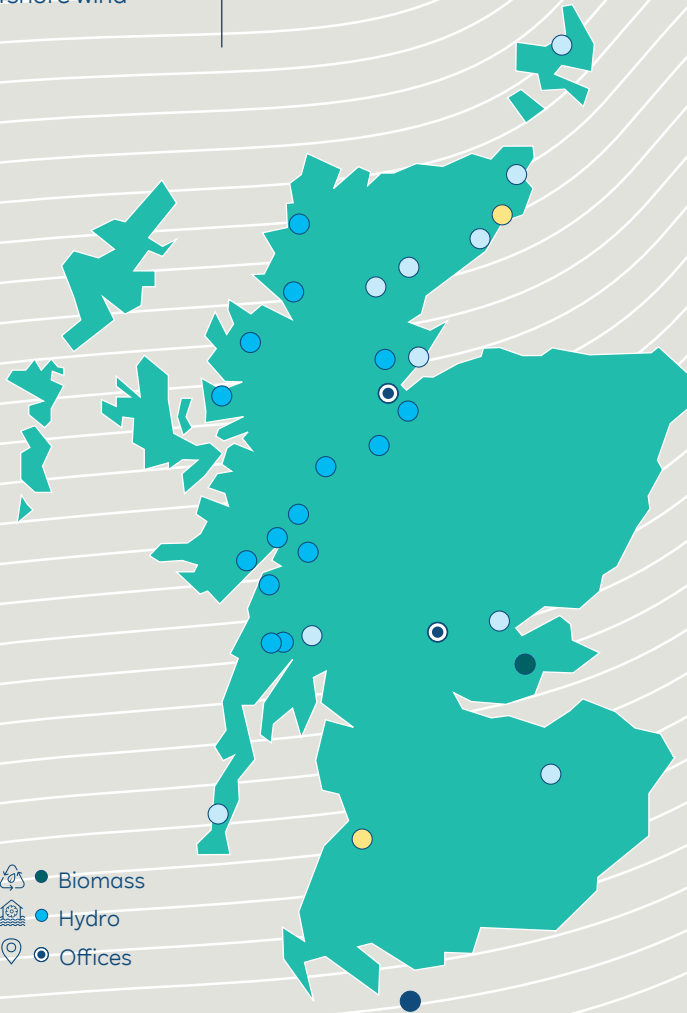

We have recently started construction of two new

Scottish onshore wind projects, Camster II and Enoch Hill, and expect to begin a third in 2024.

Alongside our onshore wind projects, we are exploring several electrolytic green hydrogen projects to provide hydrogen for use in heavy industries, homes and businesses across Scotland.
