



# Strathy Wood Wind Farm

## Public Notice - Turbine Deliveries

As part of our construction activities at Strathy Wood Wind Farm near Strathy, in Sutherland, we will be starting delivery of wind turbine components along the A836 between Scrabster Harbour and the site entrance. This is expected to begin on the 10th November and continue through into December with one convoy per day expected (Monday - Friday).

Due to the sizeable load of the deliveries, some alterations have been made at certain points along the route to allow the convoy to pass safely.

- The convoy will begin at Scrabster Harbour at approximately 09:30am each day, travelling westbound along the A836.
- The convoy will then travel for approximately 29 miles until it arrives at the site entrance just to the east of the village of Strathy. This is expected to take approximately 1.5hrs.

At all times, the convoy will be accompanied by support vehicles from our delivery partner and Police Scotland. Police Scotland will ensure that local traffic is held in place at key points along the route, allowing the convoy to pass safely.

We realise that these deliveries may cause some disruption to local journeys. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience and appreciate your patience.
